About the project:

Nowadays, we live in a changeable society where many cultures and religions meet together. Everything is changing fast because of the economic and political situation, especially migration crisis. This combined with fear is leading people to radicalization, becoming more intolerant due to their prejudices and to the lack of information.

The main activity of the project Cooperation Against Radicalization will be a Youth Exchange where young people from Spain, Portugal, Poland and the Czech Republic will have the opportunity to create a space for an open and intercultural dialog, where they can share their point of view about this issue, build their own opinions and also learn to be more tolerant and open for points of view of others.

As a useful tool in this situation, we will use cooperative games because they enable people to set aside their differences and arrive at a mutual solution for achieving a common goal. With this, we can show to young people that even though there are many differences between them (cultural, religious, social) they can effectively work all together.

Goals:

- to develop critical thinking of youth as a prevention of radicalization.
- to form their cooperative attitude, tolerance and respect for other cultures.
- to get a wider understanding about migrations and social inequalities.
- to create a space for intercultural dialogue.
- to develop and teach new educational tools for working with the issue of radicalization.

What kind of activities is waiting for you?

- Cooperative and team building games.
- Outdoor activities.
- Brainstorming, workshops, dialog and discussion.
- ActionBound (app).

Important: Every team will have the responsibility of creating some part of the program (energizers, presentation...) We will send detailed information soon :)

Participants and travel information:

There will be 6 young participants aged between 14 and 19 and 1 youth leader per country.

All activities are open for both genders. It will be recommended to all organizations to take care of gender balance during the participants' selection.

Poland - travel costs: 20 euro per participant.

Spain - travel costs: 275 euro per participant + you have 1 travel day :)

Portugal - travel costs: 360 euro per participant + you have 2 travel days :)

The tickets should be bought before the 25th of May. **It is very important to send information to the organizers about the traveling dates and times before buying the tickets. Don't buy any tickets without confirmation!!**

Spanish and Portuguese participants will fly to Prague and from there take a direct bus to Náchod.

The program will start the 8th July at noon and will finish the 14th July after lunch.
